NUHEARA UNDERTAKES CAPITAL RAISING TO SUPPORT EXPANSION WITH US RETAILERS

10 OCTOBER 2023

Key highlights

- Pro rata accelerated non-renounceable entitlement offer to raise approximately \$10.0 million (before costs) if fully subscribed
- The entitlement offer prioritises participation by existing shareholders, and if shareholders participate for their full entitlement, they will not be diluted by the current raising
- Funding to support expansion with several US retailers, including Walmart, with over 4,800 US stores retailing Nuheara's HP Hearing PRO this month, and 5,000 targeted before the end of 2023
- Nuheara's Board fully supports the Entitlement Offer and certain eligible Directors have agreed to participate

Nuheara Limited (ASX: NUH, "**Nuheara**" or the "**Company**") is pleased to announce that with the Company now commercialising its unique medical device technology, it is undertaking a 1-for-2.64 pro-rata accelerated non-renounceable entitlement offer of approximately \$10.0 million ("**Entitlement Offer**") of new fully paid ordinary shares in Nuheara ("**New Shares**") at an offer price of \$0.13 per New Share ("**Offer Price**") to support its expansion with US retailers.

It is expected that approximately 77.1 million New Shares will be issued under the Entitlement Offer (comprising approximately 37.9% of Nuheara's existing issued capital as at today's date). All New Shares issued under the Entitlement Offer will rank equally with existing ordinary shares.

The Offer Price represents a:

- 2.7% discount to the theoretical ex-rights price ("**TERP** of \$0.1336); and
- 3.7% discount to the last close price of Nuheara shares of \$0.1350 on Monday, 9 October 2023.

The Entitlement Offer will be open between 7:00am (AWST), Tuesday, 17 October 2023 and 5:00pm (AWST), Monday, 30 October 2023 to all existing shareholders at the Record Date (defined below) residing in Australia or New Zealand. Eligible shareholders can participate in the Entitlement Offer by following the instructions set out in their personalised Entitlement and Acceptance Form.

The Entitlement Offer prioritises participation by existing shareholders and if shareholders participate for their full entitlement, they will not be diluted by the current raising.

The Entitlement Offer is lead managed by Bell Potter Securities Limited ("**Bell Potter**" or the "**Lead Manager**").

Purpose of the Entitlement Offer

The Entitlement Offer strengthens Nuheara's capability to execute on its accelerated US expansion and expected future opportunities. The proceeds of the Entitlement Offer will be used to fund:

- Working capital to support increased inventory sale ramp, given the materially increasing production ahead;

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- Sales and marketing investment required to further expand points-of-sale, including in-store displays and advertising that is expected to drive sales;
- External pre-launch cost for Nuheara's next generation single-chip product which is expected to be launched in January 2024; and
- Costs of the Entitlement Offer.

Details of the Entitlement Offer

Eligible existing shareholders will be entitled to subscribe for 1 New Share for every 2.64 existing shares ("**Entitlement**") held as at 4.00pm (AWST) on Thursday, 12 October 2023 ("**Record Date**"). All New Shares issued under the Entitlement Offer will be issued at the Offer Price.

Institutional Entitlement Offer

Eligible institutional and sophisticated shareholders will be invited to participate in the institutional component of the Entitlement Offer ("**Institutional Entitlement Offer**"), which is being conducted today, Tuesday, 10 October 2023.

Eligible institutional shareholders can choose to take up all, part or none of their Entitlement. Institutional Entitlements cannot be traded on ASX or any other exchange, nor can it be privately transferred.

Institutional Entitlements that eligible institutional shareholders do not take up by the close of the Institutional Entitlement Offer, and institutional Entitlements that would otherwise have been offered to ineligible institutional shareholders, will be offered to other institutional and sophisticated investors at the Offer Price under an institutional shortfall bookbuild.

Nuheara shares will remain in a trading halt pending completion of the Institutional Entitlement Offer ("**Institutional Offer**").

Retail Entitlement Offer

Eligible retail shareholders with a registered address in Australia or New Zealand as at 4.00pm (AWST) on the Record Date, not being persons residing in the United States of America (**US**) or acting for the account or benefit of persons in the U.S. ("**Eligible Retail Shareholders**") will be invited to participate in the retail component of the Entitlement Offer ("**Retail Entitlement Offer**") at the same Offer Price and offer ratio as the Institutional Entitlement Offer. The Retail Entitlement Offer will open at 7.00am (AWST) on Tuesday, 17 October 2023 and close at 5.00pm (AWST) on Monday, 30 October 2023.

The Retail Entitlement Offer will be made under a transaction specific prospectus issued under section 713 of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth) ("**Prospectus**"). The Prospectus will be lodged with ASIC and the ASX on Tuesday, 10 October 2023 and will be dispatched to Eligible Retail Shareholders, along with personalised acceptance forms, on Tuesday, 17 October 2023.

In addition to each Eligible Retail Shareholder's Entitlement under the Retail Entitlement Offer, Eligible Retail Shareholders will be offered the opportunity to apply for additional New Shares ("**Shortfall Shares**") under a shortfall offer ("**Shortfall Offer**"). Eligible Retail Shareholders are not assured of being allocated any Shortfall Shares in excess of their Entitlement under the Shortfall Offer. Shortfall Shares allocated under the Shortfall Offer will be allocated in accordance with the allocation policy outlined in the Prospectus. The Company and the Lead Manager retain absolute discretion regarding allocation under the Shortfall Offer.

If Eligible Retail Shareholders take no action, they will not be issued New Shares and their Entitlements will lapse. Eligible Retail Shareholders who do not take up their Entitlements in full under the Retail Entitlement Offer will not receive any value or payment for those entitlements they do

not take up. The Retail Entitlement Offer is non-renounceable and cannot be traded on ASX or any other exchange, nor can it be privately transferred.

The terms and conditions under which Eligible Retail Shareholders may apply are outlined in the Prospectus.

Existing Shareholders with a registered address outside Australia or New Zealand on the Record Date or who are acting for the account or benefit of persons in the U.S. will be ineligible to participate in the Retail Entitlement Offer, other than persons that Nuheara has (with the prior written agreement of the Lead Manager in their absolute discretion) determined in its discretion are Eligible Retail Shareholders.

Director participation

The Nuheara Board fully supports the Entitlement Offer and certain eligible Company Directors have agreed to participate in the Entitlement Offer.
